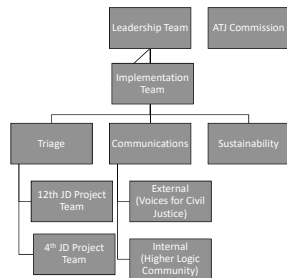

Justice for All Structure

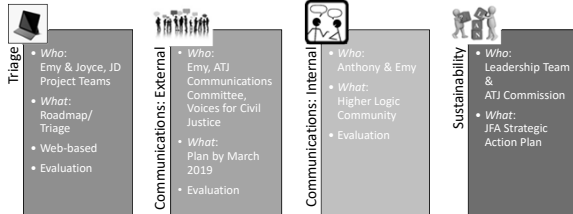
